

Summer Meals Program

Although Fremont Public Schools does not offer a summer meals program at a Fremont Public Schools building, Newaygo Public Schools is a sponsor of the Summer Food Service Program for children in Newaygo County.

Free meals will be made available to children 18 years of age and under or persons up to age 26 who are enrolled in an educational program for the mentally or physically disabled that is recognized by a State or local public educational agency. The meals will be provided without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex or disability. No paperwork is required to receive free meals.
