Community service is defined as "an act of assistance or benefit to another or others". It is implied that the service be for persons unrelated to the student, is for charitable purposes, and is most often done at a **Non-Profit agency**. **Check with your guidance counselor for prior approval IF service is for someone other than a Non-Profit.** The student may not be financially compensated for the service. Many community service organizations welcome the voluntary service of a high school student. Such organizations include, but are not limited to, Habitat for Humanity, NCCS, Recycling Center, and Gerber Memorial Health Services. Eligible activities include, but are not limited to, reading to children in the elementary grades, tutoring a peer or a younger student, mentoring younger children, volunteering at a local nursing home or hospital, working at a soup kitchen or shelter, or going on a mission trip.
