- **Early College of Newaygo County (ECNC)** is a program that allows students to extend their high school experience by one year, **earning both a high school diploma and an associate degree** with up to 62 college credits from Muskegon Community College - all completely **tuition-free!** Students apply in their sophomore year and must have a high school GPA of 2.2 or higher. - The **FAFSA** is now open! The link for this can be found on the **Senior Google Classroom** or at fafsa.gov
 - The **Gerber Foundation Scholarship** application will open on **Wednesday, October 1, 2025**, and will close on **February 28, 2026, at 4 pm ET.** The student application link and scholarship flyers are on the Foundation's website at: <https://www.gerberfoundation.org/scholarships/>. On the website you will find information for each scholarship. There is a Frequently Asked Questions section to the website, which will help address questions students may have.
 - **Michigan Works** has a Pre-Apprenticeship Career Readiness Certification program for any interested Senior that would like to explore a possible apprenticeship program after graduation. This is approximately a 90 day program for 1 to 2 hours a week which would include **Career Exploration, Micro Credentials good for resume building, Work Experience, Job Shadowing, Resume Building and Interviewing Skills workshops.** Students will walk away with a working portfolio and a certificate representing their work and time in the Michigan Works program helping them to be ready for an Apprenticeship.
