ESPORTS:

- Hunter Domine is one of the top Madden players in the state of Michigan. Currently ranked 3rd in the MHSEL (Michigan High School Esports League) and going into the playoffs. He is also our first Fremont Esports player to have an official signing day. He has been recruited by colleges since his Sophomore year. He was recently in talks with Davenport University and made the decision to accept their offer. He had his official signing day where esports coaches from both Fremont High and Davenport University watched on as he signed his promise to play Madden at the collegiate level for the Davenport Panthers
- Congratulations to Leo Nestle (Hearthstone), who has clinched a playoff spot and is currently ranked 2nd in the Eastern Region. Hunter Domine (Madden) has also secured his playoff spot and is ranked 3rd statewide. Our Super Smash Bros. Ultimate Varsity Team (Joe Campbell, Wes Campbell, Seth Ceton, Ashton Dronchi, and Russell Schubert) has qualified for MHSEL playoffs as well, currently 4th out of 103 teams in Michigan.
