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Presentation to the Board of Education On 98c Learning Loss Grant (GEER/ESSER II)

FACTS:

- MDE has allocated approximately \$37 per student to be funneled to school districts to address learning loss in students due to the pandemic.
- Fremont Public Schools, along with many other public schools, have continued to see the impacts that the pandemic has had on learning loss among students.

PLAN FOR USING 98c FUNDS:

- Funds will be used at the middle school for the IXL site licenses for the math program. This program is integrated into the classroom to help students with math fundamentals.
- Funds will be used at the middle school for the No Red Ink Program for ELA grammar remediation/instruction which is integrated into the classroom.
- Funds will be used at the high school level for an after school tutoring program to provide remediation and homework support.
- Funds will be used in an effort to assist high school level students in the cost of credit recovery in order to maintain their graduation status.
- Funds will be used at the elementary level for an online tutoring program to be integrated into the classroom for additional remedial supports. The online program can also be utilized at home to support student learning.
