Leadership Reports

Ken Haggart, Superintendent

- Ken advised the Board that in each member's packet there was a survey from Fowler Public Schools for Esser funds for their review. The survey must be completed by December 14.
- Ken met with the support staff on Friday to discuss forming an association.
- The end of fall sports season is upon us. We are basically at the tournament stage for all sports. Mr. Walls will be in to give an overview of the fall sports in December.
- Bing has reached out to the Forester to get a bid on selective cutting the properties the school district owns.
- Pete questioned where the discussion is on the Daisy Brook lunches/times/teachers, etc. may be. Fran and Jodi have talked to Ken about using the specials teachers in the rotation to help cover classrooms when we are short on substitutes. We have had more teachers taking time off this year at the beginning of the year than in previous years. The Admin team is working on ways to lighten the burden for the teachers. Kim asked about more physical activities for the elementary students rather than less. Ken has done research that shows that higher performing schools have physical education every day more PE rather than less. The Board may need to focus on elementary programming over the next few years. Pete asked about recognition of the teachers......how does the Board do that?
