Reading (Our Earth)	 Read the story together. One article per day. Adult read it, then the child repeats and read on his/her own. Do this each day. Have your child circle the words he/she knows or recognizes (a, the, is, like,). Choose one question to answer for each article. Adult can write a sentence for the child to trace or copy onto the page. Feel free to discuss other questions aloud together.
Writing (For week 2)	 Read direction and answer the writing prompt. Adult can write a sentence out for the child to trace or copy on the pages. Encourage writing his/her own name on top of each page.
Phonics & Words their Way (week 1: sp/sk/sm blends) (week 2: sc/sn/sw blends)	1.Practice and make the sounds. 2.Choose one activity sheet per day for these sounds.
Sight Words	 1.Pick 3-5 "known" words from the First 100 Sight word list, and then write on a small card/paper, 2.Add these to your cards from the first session. 3.Keeping reading and practicing the sight words each day. 4.Choose some of the activities listed on the packet.
